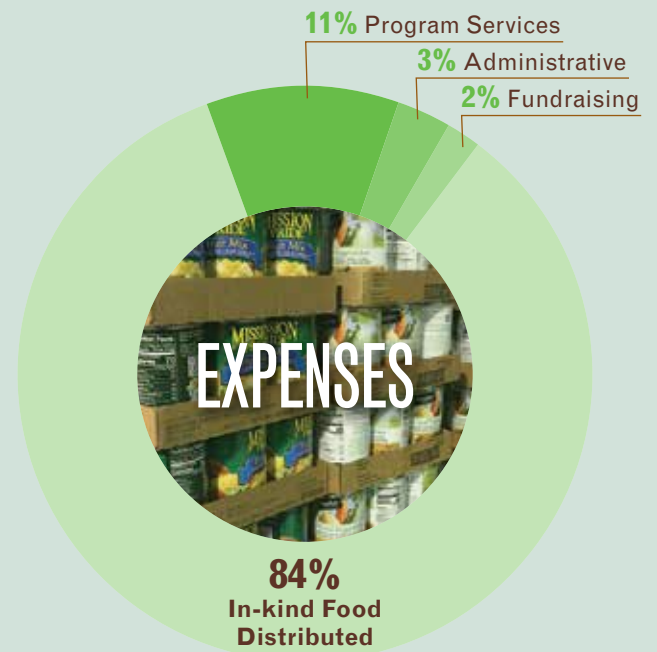
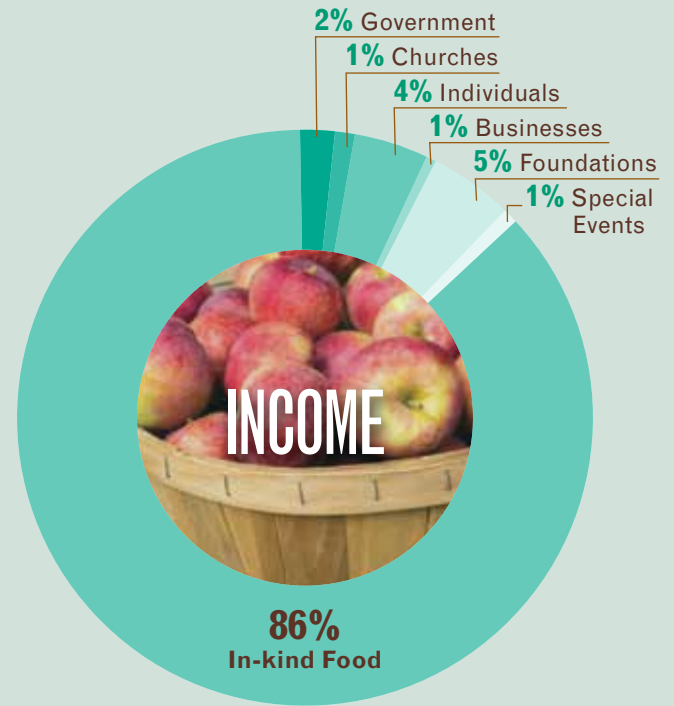

6.7 million pounds of food for a total of **4 MILLION** NOURISHING MEALS.

IN 2019 NOURISH:

- Served nearly **66,000 people** in Pierce County through 459,000 visits at 25 food distribution sites throughout the county.
- Operated with only **15 full time staff** on a modest operating budget of 1.8 million dollars – 100% funded through donations.
- **Served 7% of the Pierce County population** visiting a Nourish Food Bank at least one time.
- Distributed **6.7 million pounds of food** totaling more than 4 million nourishing meals.
- Purchased more than **\$219,000 of nutritious food** to ensure the food bank shelves are stocked with a healthy and well balanced selection.
- **Began service at all 5 community & technical colleges in Pierce County** in response to the increasing issue of student hunger.
- Supported vibrant children, productive adults and healthy seniors. **1 in 3 Nourish clients are children** ages 0-18.
- **Served our seniors** who make up 17% of our customers.
- Operated during **evenings and weekends** to lighten the burden for students and working families stretched thin.
- Provided approximately **75,000 volunteer hour opportunities for over 1000** community members. This is equivalent to 36 full time staff.
- Coordinated **60 Food Drives** with community organizations and businesses which brought in more than **23,000 pounds of food** to stock our food bank shelves.
- Won the **Tacoma-Pierce County Chamber Spotlight on Business Award** for the nonprofit category.
- **Partnered with The Outreach Program** to work with corporate and community volunteer groups to assemble nutritious dried non-perishable meals.
- **Partnered with the University of Washington-Tacoma** to determine the culturally and religiously significant foods needed at the various Nourish Food Banks.
